# THE NOSSI 4-YEAR PROMISE

Nossi College of Art believes no creative person should, for financial reasons, be left behind in the pursuit of a college degree. Therefore, all recipients of the TENNESSEE PROMISE may also participate in Nossi College of Art's NOSSI 4-YEAR PROMISE Scholarship. It is a needs-based scholarship intended for bachelor degree seeking students. This scholarship is intended to close the "gap" that may exist after all other grants, loans and scholarships are applied to the student's tuition. The amount of this scholarship is limited to a maximum amount of \$1,200 per semester. This scholarship will be applied directly to each student's tuition. It will be re-evaluated at the end of each semester. After the evaluation, the amount of the scholarship may (1) stay the same, (2) be increased, (3) be decreased or (4) be discontinued (if the student no longer qualifies).

## HOW TO APPLY

To apply for this scholarship, the applicant must:

1. Apply for, and meet all Tennessee Promise Scholarship requirements
2. Meet with the Financial Aid Director to request consideration
3. Complete the financial aid process at Nossi College of Art
4. Discuss his/her specific financial situation with his admissions representative
5. Submission of college application required for scholarship approval

## RECIPIENT'S NOTIFICATION AND ACCEPTANCE

As this is a need-based scholarship, all applicants who qualify will be notified of the amount of their individual scholarship based on their specific financial situation. When the recipient accepts the scholarship, he/she agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of the NOSSI 4-YEAR PROMISE Scholarship.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE NOSSI 4-YEAR PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP

The college believes all scholarship recipients should maintain a high standard of academic excellence. To encourage and foster that excellence in education, the recipient must therefore make satisfactory academic progress throughout the length of his/her program. Satisfactory academic progress for the purpose of the scholarship is defined as maintaining academic progression through the student's program as explained in the college catalog.

The following rules and regulations apply to this scholarship:

1. Maintain a satisfactory attendance record as described in the attendance policy of the college catalog
2. Meet all financial obligations
3. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of two courses toward their degree
4. Yearly completion of his/her FAFSA by February 15 of that current year
5. If applicable, every scholarship student's parent(s) must apply for PLUS
6. Every scholarship student must accept all Federal Aid offered
7. The actual disbursement of this scholarship will be applied retroactively to each student's tuition payment at the end of each semester -- if the student has complied with all rules and regulations. If the student has not met all the requirements (withdraws in the middle of a semester, for example), then the scholarship will not be disbursed and the total tuition amount will be the student's responsibility.

## CONDITIONS FOR REVOKING THE SCHOLARSHIP

Disbursements of the scholarship will be terminated any semester when it is determined:

1. The recipient has failed to maintain satisfactory academic progress
2. The recipient has not met his/her financial obligations.
