Nossi Hope Scholarship

Nossi College of Art believes no creative person should, for financial reasons, be left behind in the pursuit of a college degree. Recipients of the Tennessee Education Lottery Scholarship (TELS) also known as (a) Tennessee Hope Scholarship (b) Tennessee Hope Scholarship need-based supplemental award (c) General Assembly Merit Scholarship or (d) Tennessee Hope Access Grant, may participate in the Nossi Hope Scholarship. Therefore, all Tennessee residents who are a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen, graduating from an eligible high school must enroll in college within one (1) year after graduation. The scholarship will be disbursed at the rate of \$633 each semester for a maximum of 11 semesters. It will be applied directly to each student's tuition. The Nossi Hope scholarship **cannot** be combined with The Nossi Promise scholarship.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Be accepted in a degree program at Nossi
2. Have presented your art portfolio to the admissions director
3. Show proof of high school graduation
4. Speak with a financial aid advisor to request consideration
5. Submission of scholarship application required

RECIPIENTS' NOTIFICATION AND ACCEPTANCE

All applicants will receive notification on the status of their scholarship. When the recipient accepts the scholarship, they agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the scholarship committee.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE NOSSI HOPE SCHOLARSHIP

The college believes that all scholarship recipients must maintain a high standard of academic excellence that they exhibited through their high school years that brought them the reward of the Nossi Hope Scholarship. To encourage and foster excellence in education, the recipient must therefore make satisfactory academic progress throughout the length of the program.

Satisfactory academic progress for the purpose of the scholarship is defined as:

1. Maintain a minimum of a "B" cumulative grade point average
2. Pass all subjects
3. Maintain a satisfactory attendance record as described in the attendance policy of the college catalog
4. Meet all financial obligations

CONDITIONS FOR REVOKING THE SCHOLARSHIP

Disbursements of the scholarship will be terminated any semester when it is determined:

1. The recipient has failed to maintain a "B" cumulative grade point average.
2. The recipient has failed a course.
3. The recipient has not met their financial obligations.
4. The recipient is not enrolled at the time scholarship is awarded.
