NOSSI SCHOLASTIC SCHOLARSHIP

The Nossi Scholastic Scholarship is awarded to a high school senior who has shown exceptional creativity in the visual arts by being selected for a Silver Key, Gold Key, or America Vision Medalist by the Scholastic Art Awards.

The amount of the Nossi Scholastic Scholarship is \$4,400. The award is disbursed towards the recipients tuition after the mid-term exam each semester at the rate of \$400 up to 11 semesters for a bachelor's degree as satisfactory academic progress is made through their program.

RECIPIENTS NOTIFICATION AND ACCEPTANCE

All applicants will receive notification on the status of their scholarship. The recipient must officially accept the award offered by the college and agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the award committee. Each discipline requires additional application requirements.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Request the scholarship application prior to enrolling from your admissions representative.
2. Student must provide documentation of the Scholastic Award at the time of application.
3. Submission of college application required for scholarship approval.

CONDITIONS FOR THE AWARD

The college believes all award recipients must maintain a high standard of academic excellence. To encourage and foster excellence in education, the award recipient must therefore make satisfactory academic progress throughout the length of the program.

Satisfactory academic progress for the purpose of the award is defined as:

1. Maintaining a minimum "B" cumulative grade point average.
2. Pass all subjects.
3. Maintain a satisfactory attendance record as described in the attendance policy of the college catalog.
4. Meet all financial obligations.
5. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of two courses toward the degree of their major.

To ensure the student has met academic satisfactory progress during the first semester, the scholarship will be distributed after the first mid-term examination results are completed. Subsequent disbursements are made after each mid-term exam of the remaining semesters. The bachelor's degree has eleven (11) semesters in the program. The amount of the award is up to \$4,400, distributed four hundred dollars (\$400) each semester for a maximum of eleven (11) semesters. All funds will be applied to the student's tuition balance.

CONDITIONS FOR REVOKING THE AWARD

Disbursements of the scholarship will be terminated any semester when it is determined:

1. The recipient has failed to maintain a "B" cumulative grade point average.
2. The recipient failed a course.
3. The recipient has not met their financial obligations.
4. The recipient has not met the college's satisfactory attendance policy.
