Culinary Arts Advisory Board Scholarship

Nossi College of Art is proud to partner with distinguished organizations throughout Middle Tennessee and offer the Culinary Arts Advisory Board Scholarship to their current employees wishing to pursue a culinary degree. Nossi believes no creative person should, for financial reasons, be left behind in the pursuit of their college degree. The amount of the scholarship is up to \$1500. It will be disbursed \$250 each semester for up to a maximum of six (6) semesters. It will be applied directly to each student's tuition.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Be accepted in the Culinary Arts degree program at Nossi College of Art
2. Show proof of employment by an organization on the Nossi advisory board
3. Show proof of high school graduation or equivalent GED/HiSET
4. Speak with an admission representative to request consideration
5. Submission of scholarship application required

RECIPIENT'S NOTIFICATION AND ACCEPTANCE

All applicants will receive notification on the status of their scholarship. When the recipient accepts the scholarship, they agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the scholarship committee.

CONDITIONS FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

The college believes all scholarship recipients should maintain a high standard of academic excellence. To encourage and foster excellence in education, the recipient therefore **must** make satisfactory academic progress throughout the length of the program. Satisfactory academic progress for the purpose of the scholarship is defined as maintaining academic progression through the student's program as explained in the college catalog.

The following rules and regulations apply to this scholarship:

1. Recipients must be employed, and stay employed, by an organization on the Nossi advisory board during the six (6) semesters to receive scholarship funds
2. Recipients must provide proof of employment (i.e. paystub, letter from employer, schedule, etc.) to the Registrar within two (2) weeks prior to the end of each semester.
3. Maintain a satisfactory attendance record as described in the attendance policy of the college catalog
4. Meet all financial obligations
5. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of two courses toward their degree
6. Each year, every scholarship recipient must complete their FAFSA by February 15th of that year
7. The actual disbursement of this scholarship will be applied retroactively to each student's tuition at the end of each semester, if the student has complied with all rules and regulations. If the student has not met all the requirements (withdraws in the middle of a semester, for example), the scholarship will **NOT** be disbursed, and the total tuition amount will be the student's responsibility.

CONDITIONS FOR REVOKING THE SCHOLARSHIP

Disbursements of the scholarship will be terminated any semester when it is determined:

1. The recipient has failed to maintain satisfactory academic progress (SAP).
2. The recipient has not met their financial obligations.
3. The recipient is not enrolled at the time the scholarship is awarded.
4. The recipient is no longer employed by an organization on the Nossi advisory board.
