RULES AND REGULATIONS

THE CONTINUING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Continuing Education Scholarship was established for students enrolling in Nossi College of Art & Design who have special financial needs and who have been previously enrolled in another college. This scholarship is designed to help those students who knew that they wanted to pursue a college education, attended another institution of higher learning and now wish to continue their education by earning a creative degree at Nossi College of Art & Design. This is a needs-based scholarship.

The amount of this scholarship varies and is limited to a maximum amount of \$1,200 per semester. Scholarship monies will be applied directly to each student's tuition. Each student granted this scholarship will be evaluated at the end of each Financial Aid Award year. At the end of the evaluation, the amount of the scholarship may (1) stay the same, (2) be increased, (3) be decreased or (4) be discontinued (if the student no longer qualifies).

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Be accepted in a degree program at Nossi College of Art & Design
- 2. Request scholarship application during the financial aid process
- 3. Complete the financial aid process

RECIPIENT'S NOTIFICATION AND ACCEPTANCE

The Continuing Education Scholarship is a need-based scholarship. All applicants who qualify will be notified of the amount of their individual scholarship based on their specific financial need. When the recipient accepts the scholarship, they agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the Continuing Education Scholarship.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CONTINUING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

Nossi College of Art & Design believes all scholarship recipients should maintain a high standard of academic excellence. To encourage and foster excellence in education, the recipient *must*, therefore, make satisfactory academic progress throughout the length of his/her program. Satisfactory academic progress (SAP) for the purpose of the scholarship is defined as maintaining academic progression through the student's program as explained in the college catalog.

The following rules and regulations apply to this scholarship:

- 1. Maintain a satisfactory attendance record as described in the attendance policy of the college catalog
- 2. Meet all financial obligations
- 3. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of two courses toward their degree
- 4. Each year, every scholarship recipient must complete their FAFSA by February 15th of that year
- 5. If applicable, every scholarship recipient's parent(s) must apply for PLUS LOAN
- 6. Every scholarship student must accept all Federal Aid offered
- 7. The actual disbursement of this scholarship will be applied retroactively to each student's tuition at the end of each semester if the student has complied with all rules and regulations. If the student has not met all the requirements (withdraws in the middle of a semester, for example), then the scholarship will **NOT** be disbursed and the total tuition amount will be the student's responsibility.

CONDITIONS FOR REVOKING THE SCHOLARSHIP

Disbursements of the scholarship will be terminated any semester when it is determined:

- 1. The recipient has failed to maintain satisfactory academic progress (SAP).
- 2. The recipient has not met their financial obligations.
- 3. The recipient is not enrolled at the time the scholarship is awarded.
