RULES AND REGULATIONS

AGREEMENT

THE GOVERNOR'S SCHOLARSHIP

The Governor's Scholarship is awarded to Alumni of the Governor's School for the Arts in the visual arts and filmmaking programs. The scholarship recipient must be a first-time freshman, enroll within one (1) year after graduation, and have a 3.0+ GPA or 21+ ACT on their high school transcript.

The amount of The Governor's Scholarship is \$8,800. The award is disbursed towards the recipient's tuition after the mid-term exam each semester at the rate of \$800 up to 11 semesters for a bachelor's degree as satisfactory academic progress is made through their program. This award may not be combined with the Mahtaban, Presidential, or additional Nossi College of Art talent scholarships.

RECIPIENT'S NOTIFICATION AND ACCEPTANCE

All applicants will receive notification on the status of their scholarship. The recipient must officially accept the award offered by Nossi College of Art & Design and agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the scholarship committee. Each discipline requires additional application requirements.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Request the scholarship application prior to enrolling from your admissions representative.
- 2. Student must provide documentation of completion of the GSA program at the time of application.
- 3. Submission of college application required for scholarship approval.

CONDITIONS FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

The college believes all scholarship recipients must maintain a high standard of academic excellence that earned them the reward of The Governor's Scholarship. To encourage and foster excellence in education, the recipient must therefore make satisfactory academic progress throughout the length of the program.

Satisfactory academic progress for the purpose of the scholarship is defined as:

- 1. Maintaining a minimum "B" cumulative grade point average
- 2. Pass all subjects
- 3. Maintain a satisfactory attendance record as described in the attendance policy of the college catalog
- 4. Meet all financial obligations
- 5. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of two courses toward the degree of their major

To ensure the student has met academic satisfactory progress during the first semester, the scholarship will be disbursed after the first mid-term examination results are completed. Subsequent disbursements are made after each mid-term exam of the remaining semesters. The bachelor's degree has eleven (11) semesters in the program. The amount of the award is up to \$8,800, distributed eight hundred dollars (\$800) each semester for a maximum or eleven (11) semesters. All funds will be applied to the student's tuition balance.

CONDITIONS FOR REVOKING THE SCHOLARSHIP

Disbursements of scholarship will be terminated any semester when it is determined:

- 1. The recipient has failed to maintain a "B" cumulative grade point average.
- 2. The recipient failed a course.
- 2. The recipient has not met their financial obligations.
- 3. The recipient has not met the college's satisfactory attendance policy.
